Never drink bottled or filtered water

Several days ago my wife and I were invited over to a couple's house for dinner. While we were there we were offered a glass of water out of one of those popular filter pitchers. Our friends then began to tell us that tap water was really bad because of the contaminants that it contained. I don't think they knew how involved I was with water treatment. They were shocked when I told them I didn't trust filter pitchers because they simply did not do a good job. Since my staff and I are constantly being bombarded with questions about water I figured it was time to give everyone the facts.

So here they are, 50% of the households in America use a filter pitcher. It is exciting to me that the message that I have been preaching for 26 years is finally being heard. People are becoming more and more health conscious. What saddened me is that these "filter pitchers" do little more than improve the taste, smell and color of the still toxic water people are drinking. So just because a product is on TV and makes all kinds of claims, it doesn't mean that it works.

As always our government has basically ignored the facts that huge amounts of poisons, toxic chemicals, inorganic calcium, herbicides, pesticides, fertilizers, parasites, fungi, and viruses are being pumped into our home through the "drinking water". The reality is over 100 million people in this country receive toxic chemicals and fluoride in water from their municipalities and their wells.

Next let's address the bottled water fiasco in the United States. Literally everywhere I go people are drinking bottled water. It's amazing, but 2/3 of Americans are spending in excess of 6 billion dollars a year on bottled water and home treatment systems that simply don't work. Watch the commercials and advertisements, there are over 100 companies which promise to improve taste and color of your water, while they do nothing to get rid of the poisons.

How many of you have heard me say on radio or television, "the most important thing you can do for your health, even if you don't do anything else is to drink 1/2 of your body weight in ounces of purified water per day?" **Example:** If you weigh 200 pounds you should drink 100 ounces of purified water a day.

So let me share with you a brief overview of the thousands of useless products that are being sold to you claiming to provide you with pure water. Then I'll tell you what really works and what my family and I use.

The first category is bottled water. The biggest problem with bottled water is that it is basically unregulated. In fact, almost all bottled water is municipally treated tap water or sewage water. Out of 52 brands surveyed by the FDA, 31% contained bacteria, inorganic calcium and many still contain chlorine and fluoride. On top of everything else, have you ever bought bottled water in a plastic jug, and gagged because of the taste when you drank it? I know I have. Let me tell you why. The low grade plastic containers that most manufacturers use can leech poisons, such as methyl chlorides and carcinogens, that damage

the reproductive organs. In spite of these dangers, millions of people are paying up to \$3 per gallon for "bottled water".

Next let us talk about the "filtration systems" used by over 100 million Americans, such as the filter pitchers. Most of the "filters" use carbon ceramic or alumina. These filters can make the water cleaner and remove some of the smell and taste. They are however, pretty useless at removing arsenic, mercury, copper, fertilizers, parasites, inorganic calcium, and bacteria. In fact, the filter used can actually breed bacteria and make the filtered water even more unsafe than the original water filtered. Always remember that filters catch contaminants like a net. Sooner or later the net fills up and the filter becomes totally ineffective. This can leave you with a higher risk of contaminants or illness.

Over 30 years ago I was told by one of my professors at Florida State University, that distilled water was the best and purest available. Now after 20 years of using distilled water, I believe more than ever in its purity.

It is the **only** type of system that actually removes the water from the contaminants, rather than remove the contaminants from the water. Let me explain. The water is boiled and turned into steam . The temperature is 212°F (100°C). This kills cysts, bacteria and viruses. The steam then rises leaving all heavy metals (lead, copper, mercury, inorganic calcium) behind. The steam is then recondensed using a stainless steel coil. Before it is discharged, it passes through a coconut carbon filter, to remove any taste. Then the pure water is collected and stored. If you use a high-quality, well-constructed distiller, you will remove literally every kind of bacteria, viruses, parasites, pesticides, herbicides, heavy metals, chemicals, inorganic calcium and even radioactive waste.

I know of no other system that **always** removes all impurities without losing its effectiveness over time. Ever so often the boil tank will need to be cleaned. It is super easy, and I am always amazed at the amount of inorganic calcium and contaminants, literally pounds, that come out of my water. Have you ever heard of hardening of the arteries? The arteries become calcified. The calcium build up is primarily inorganic calcium in your water. Basically dissolved rock. This rock cannot be used by the your body so it is stored in the soft tissue, joints and arteries causing heart problems and arthritis.

The problem with distillers is that they are normally very expensive. They can cost several thousand dollars. Well I knew that most of you were not going to be willing to invest in that kind of money, so I started doing some extensive research. Finally I discovered a product that was affordable, yet did an excellent job. It is called the **Waterwise 8800**. It is simply state of the art in countertop distillers.

When I first started looking at a countertop product I must admit I was a bit skeptical. A system that gave you the top quality water in a compact good-looking product was more than I could have expected. Well let's say I thoroughly inspected and verified its capabilities and to my delight it passed my standards with flying colors.

Let me detail to you what my criteria are when evaluating a distiller.

1. It has to be easy to use

If it is complicated I am not interested. I mean I get aggravated when I try and program my VCR. So if it's a hassle I'm not signing up. Well the Waterwise 8800 is simple, just fill it up with tap water and push start. It even automatically turns off when the cycle is done. How simple.

2. Investment value

If you want to spend \$100 on a cheap filter, that is exactly what you will get. A cheap product that is useless. My theory is why bother to waste the \$100. It's kind of like buying something you know you don't want because its cheaper than something you want. I promise all that will do is frustrate you. You'll always be thinking why didn't I just wait and buy what I wanted. Also when you look at your long term health investment, it's really a great investment for you and your family. It only costs about 0.25 cents per gallon for pure water using the Waterwise 8800. If your buying bottled water at \$1.50 per gallon and you use 30 gallons a week, that's over \$2,000 per year which is over 5 times the one time cost of a distiller that will last for many, many years.

3. Water production

This incredible unit can make up to 6 gallons of water a day of the purest water possible.

One of the first things that friends do when they come over to our house is to ask for a glass of water. Our four children drink water constantly. The reason most kids don't drink water is it tastes bad. I mean lets be real - tap water is horrible. My 17 year old son, who is a Junior in college at Southeastern University in Lakeland Florida, even brings his water jugs home on the weekend so he can have great tasting healthy water to drink. This unit even comes with a one gallon Lexan polycarbonate collector bottle which is the highest quality plastic in the industry. Remember I mentioned earlier that storing water in cheap plastic doesn't work because contaminants leach into the water

4. Maintenance and cleaning

Ever so often because of the scale that builds up in the boiling tank it will be necessary to clean the tank. This is a very easy process, you can use some vinegar or for very hard water, I use Waterwise Kleanwise. Kleanwise is a bio-degradable phosphate free product that dissolves scale without scrubbing. Also the boil tank is made from high quality stainless steel to ensure many years of excellent service.

5. Post filtration

Sometimes water quality is so bad that organic chemicals can convert into gas when boiled. However Waterwise uses a coconut shell carbon filter which removes any gases which may form. After the steam has been converted into water this is the final treatment. The coconut shell carbon by the way is the highest grade available. Many other types of carbon filters even add silver which can recontaminate your water.

6. Guarantee

I have known Jack, the owner of Waterwise, for 20 years. He and his wife actually came to me for nutritional counseling back in the 80's. This man practices what he preaches.

His commitment to you is simple, each unit comes with a one year warranty and a 100 day money back guarantee. Waterwise distillers are used by missionary's and science labs all over the world. In fact the Peace Corps use this distiller. Let me make a point. If the Peace Corps trusts Waterwise to purify sewage ridden, bacteria ridden, disease ridden water to get crystal clear drinking water, I'm sure it can do an incredible job on your tap water.

That brings me to another point. Two years ago, here in Polk County Florida where I live we had three hurricanes hit us within 6 weeks. I have a backup generator which easily runs my distiller. Had I not had a distiller I would not have had purified water to drink. We lost our power for over one week. So when it comes to disaster preparedness, enough said.
